**ORDER DECLARING  
“MAINE HEROES” FESTIVAL AND PARADE**

**ORDERED**, that Friday, April 8, 2005 is hereby declared as “Maine Heroes” Festival & Parade;

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the festival runs from 3:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. at the Monument Square/One City Center area;

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the following streets will be closed for the parade from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. including sidewalks:

Spring Street (from Temple Street to High Street)  
High Street (from Spring Street to Congress Street)  
Congress Street (from High Street to Temple Street)  
Federal Street Extension  
Free Street (from High Street to Temple Street)

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the festival zone includes all the adjacent sidewalks on both sides of the parade route, as well as the squares and parks along the route: Congress Square, Monument Square, One City Center, sidewalk area in front of Hay building and Portland Museum of Art;

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the festival speech areas will be:

Monument Square  
One City Center  
Congress Street/Center Street area beside Monument Square

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the Maine Heroes Festival and Parade and the festival zone will be closed to vendors, other than those licensed for the festival, from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., pursuant to section 19-17 of the City Code;

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that alcoholic beverages shall not be sold or consumed on the streets or public property during said festival;

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the City Manager is authorized to issue such other temporary licenses, including licenses for food establishments, as may be required by the City Code, provided that all other applicable requirements of said Code have been met.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED,** that for-profit vendors will be charged a fee of \$250 to participate in the festival.
