ORDER DECLARING 2005
“SUMMER EVENTS/CONCERT SERIES FESTIVAL”

ORDERED, that June 24 – August 29, 2005 is hereby declared to be the “Summer Events/Concert Series Festival” following the below schedule:

Take Your Dog to Work Day

Friday, June 24 from 11 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Alive at Five Outdoor Concerts (national recording acts)

Thursdays, July 7, 14, 21, 28, August 4, 11 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Kids Activity Days

Wednesdays, July 6, 13, 20, 27 (kids shows) from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

Acoustic Music Series

Fridays, July 1, 8, 15, 22, 29, August 5, 12, 19, 26 (acoustic folk) from noon to 1:00 p.m.

Movies in the Park

Monday's, July 18, 25, August 1, 8, 15 (family movies) from dusk to 9:00 p.m.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the following will be considered the festival area:

- For the Take Your Dog to Work Day event: Congress Square Park and surrounding sidewalks of High Street and Congress Street.

- For the Alive at Five Outdoor Concerts: Monument Square, Monument Way, and the sidewalk areas in front of One City Center, as well as Federal Street Ext. and sidewalk areas abutting Federal Street Ext.
- For the Kids Activity Days: Lobsterman Park and surrounding sidewalks of Temple Street and Middle Street.

- For the Acoustic Music Series: Post Office Park and surrounding sidewalks of Exchange Street, Middle Street, and Market Street. Congress Square Park and surrounding sidewalks of High Street and Congress Street.
- For the Movies in the Park: Congress Square Park and surrounding sidewalks of High Street and Congress Street.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the following streets will need to be closed to traffic for the Alive at Five outdoor concerts:

3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
Federal Street Extension

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Festival shall be closed to licensed street vendors as provided in §19-17 of the City Code;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is authorized to issue a revocable permit to Downtown Improvement District, d/b/a Portland Downtown District, under §25-27 of the City Code to conduct said Festival, subject to the direction and control of the City Manager and to the following specific conditions:

1. Portland's Downtown District shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City of Portland, its officers and employees, from and against all claims arising out of or resulting from the Festival and/or use of City streets and property for said Festival, and shall procure and maintain public liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$400,000 combined single limit for personal or bodily injury, death or property damage and covering the obligation of indemnification hereunder. The District shall provide the City with a certificate showing evidence of such insurance and showing the City as an additional insured on said insurance.
2. No alcoholic beverages may be sold on the streets or public property during the Festival within the area of the Festival except at the Alive at Five Outdoor Concert Series, subject to meeting all liquor licensing requirements.
3. Portland's Downtown District shall have sole authority over participating vendors at the events/ concerts and may charge a fee to vendors for the opportunity to vend at the events/concerts.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is authorized to issue such other temporary licenses, including licenses for food service establishments, as may be required by the City Code, provided that all other applicable Code requirements for the operation of the Festival has been met.
