AMENDMENT TO PORTLAND CITY CODE
SECTION 28-101 (TOWING AND IMMOBILIZATION OF VEHICLES)
SUBSECTION (b) (SCOFFLAW), RE: "BOOT" FEES

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND,
MAINE IN CITY COUNCIL ASSEMBLED AS FOLLOWS:**

*1. That Section 28-101(Towing and Immobilization of Vehicles),
Subsection (b)(Scofflaw), of the Portland City Code is hereby
amended to read as follows:*

Sec. 28-101. Applicability.

. . . .

(b) *Scofflaw.* Any vehicle which has accumulated three (3) or more notices of violation of any parking regulation or regulations made pursuant to this chapter for which there has been neither payment of waiver fees nor issuance of court process and which is then parked in violation of any such provision may, at the option of any city police, parking control or other officer authorized to enforce the parking regulations of the city, be immobilized in place or may be removed and stored pursuant to the provisions of this chapter until all waiver fees established pursuant to 30-A M.R.S.A. § 3009 for all such outstanding notices of violations and also the charges authorized by article IV have been paid or until the requirements of section 28-103(b) or (c) have been met. If impoundment by immobilization is utilized, a charge of ~~forty~~ fifty dollars (~~\$40.00~~\$50.00) shall be charged and paid prior to such release.
