**RESOLVE APPROPRIATING \$275,000
FOR REPAIR AND RENOVATIONS AT THE
INTERNATIONAL MARINE TERMINAL**

WHEREAS, as the city-owned International Marine Terminal building and property must be repaired and renovated immediately due to structural problems; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Sec. 6 of the City Charter authorizes the City Council to appropriate funds to any purpose or object for which there has been no appropriation for the current year, or for which the appropriation for the current year has proved insufficient; and

WHEREAS, the City appropriation of funds in the FY'05 budget for the IMT building and property is not sufficient to cover the necessary repairs and renovations;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that \$275,000 is appropriated from the general fund undesignated fund balance for repairs and renovations at the International Marine Terminal as shown on Attachment A hereto, including the purchase and installation of a RUBB building at that site for the purpose of providing warehouse space.
