**ORDER SETTING PUBLIC HEARING ON ISSUANCE OF
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,180,000 AND
RATIFYING ORDER NOS. 106-05/06 AND 107-05/06**

ORDERED, that the Portland City Council will hold a public hearing in the City Council Chambers at Portland City Hall, 389 Congress Street on May 1, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. to consider the following:

1. The issuance of City general obligation bonds in the principal amount not to exceed \$1,180,000 and the appropriation of the proceeds of such bonds to finance the purchase and installation of the following capital equipment:

- Fire Department: Ambulance
- Public Works Department: 5 rubbish packers
- Building Improvements: MIS HVAC unit
- Fish Exchange Auction System

2. An order ratifying Order Nos. 106-05/06 and 107-05/06 previously adopted by the City Council on November 21, 2005 authorizing issuance of the City's general obligation bonds in the principal amount not to exceed \$9,570,000 and appropriating the proceeds of such bonds to finance the following capital improvements:

- Transportation: FHWA: Allen's Corner, Auburn Street (Lyseth Moore entry to Summit Street), Warren Avenue Phase I of 15% match (Hicks Street to Applicator Sales) paving projects, Kent Street (Brighton Ave to end) paving, Greenwood Lane (Washington to Palmer) Phase I paving.
- Buildings: City Hall Clock Tower Restoration
- Ports: IMT Ramp – for ferry service
- Parks: Memorial Field Lighting, Back Cove Trail, Phase I, Skatepark Design, Evergreen Cemetery Garage Replacement, Reforestation, Payson Park Tennis Courts and Golf Course-Building Improvements
- Downtown Improvements: Longfellow Square Lighting

- Equipment: Radio System Upgrade, Mini Pumper for Cushings Island, and Fireboat additional funding.
- Sewer: Kent Street
- Combined Sewer Overflow: Hall Street, Lucas Street culvert, Maine Avenue to Drake Street, Wellwood Road, Stroudwater, Loraine, Kineo, Frye, Preliminary Survey-Bay, Read, Glenngarden, Preliminary Engineering-Ray Street, Preliminary Engineering – West Side Sanitary Sewer Replacement; Preliminary Engineering – Detention ponds on East and West Branch of Capisic Pond.
- Public Art: funding for public arts at one-half of one percent of the regular CIP
- Land Bank: funding for Land Bank at one-half of one percent of the regular CIP

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the foregoing list is a non-exclusive list of projects that will be considered by the City Council at said public hearing or prior to final City Council action to be taken at a Council meeting to be held, unless otherwise rescheduled at 7:00 p.m. on May 15, 2006, and may be expanded, reduced or revised by the City Council at said public hearing or prior to final City Council action.
