**ORDER APPROPRIATING FEDERAL HOME FUNDS TO  
BAYSIDE NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION  
RE: LAND ACQUISITION AND REHABILITATION OF BUILDING**

**ORDERED**, that up to \$200,000 of Federal HOME funds, is hereby appropriated to be used by Bayside Neighborhood Association for land acquisition at Myrtle and Oxford Streets and rehabilitation of the 10 Mechanic Street building after it is re-located to Myrtle and Oxford Streets, said rehabilitated building to be sold to an eligible Homeport buyer, said funds to be repaid to the City by December 31, 2005; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the City Manager is authorized to enter into appropriate agreements with Bayside Neighborhood Association for the allocation of such funds, for the sale of the building to an eligible Homeport buyer and the repayment of the funds; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that this Order is enacted as an Emergency to take effect immediately, pursuant to Article II, Section 8 of the Portland City Charter, in order to permit removal of the building from its current site no later than August 22, 2005.
