**ORDER DECLARING 81st ANNUAL ST. PETER'S
BAZAAR/STREET FESTIVAL, AUGUST 13th AND 14th, AND
FOUR MILE ROAD RACE ON AUGUST 12th**

ORDERED, that Saturday August 13, and Sunday, August 14, 2005, are hereby declared "St. Peter's Bazaar and Street Festival";

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the St. Peter's Four Mile Road Race is approved for 7:00 p.m., Friday, August 12, 2005, with the closing of India Street from Federal to Fore Streets for the start of said Race from approximately 6:55 - 7:10 p.m.;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that Federal Street from India Street to Franklin Street Arterial be closed to vehicular traffic on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, August 12, 13 and 14, from Noon to Midnight of each day and shall be posted "No Parking";

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Festival area is closed to street vendors pursuant to Sec. 19-17 of the City Code;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is authorized to issue a revocable permit under Sec. 25-27 of the City Code to St. Peter's Church for use of the above described area for the Festival, subject to the following conditions:

*No sale of alcoholic beverages on the streets or public property during the Festival;

*St. Peter's Church shall defend, indemnify and hold the City harmless from and against all claims arising out of activities during said Festival and/or Road Race and shall provide and maintain public liability insurance coverage in the amount of at least \$400,000, combined single limit for personal or bodily injury, death, or property damage, with the City of Portland named as an additional insured thereon; said indemnification and insurance provision shall also be provided in regard to hanging the banner over Congress Street; and

*St. Peter's Church shall reimburse any costs incurred by city departments in providing services for the Festival and/or Road Race, including but not

limited to, police department charges, public works fees, parking control fees, inspection services fees, city clerk's license fees and parks and recreation fees;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is authorized to issue such other temporary licenses, including licenses for food service establishments, as may be required by the City Code, provided all other applicable requirements of said Code have been met regarding the operation of the Festival.
