ORDER AMENDING COUNCIL RULE 18 – RECONSIDERATION

ORDERED, that Council Rule 18 (Reconsideration) is hereby amended as follows:

Rule 18. Reconsideration

When a vote is passed, it shall be in order for any member who voted in the majority, or in the negative on a tie vote to move a reconsideration thereof, at the time, or the next stated meeting, but not afterwards, and when a motion of reconsideration is decided, that vote shall not be reconsidered. No motion to reconsider a vote passed at a previous meeting shall be in order for consideration at the next stated meeting unless an item to that effect is contained in the agenda for such next stated meeting or unless seven of the members consent to such reconsideration ~~at that meeting~~. A citizen petition, or zone change petition, once presented to and finally acted upon by the Council shall not again be received by the Council in the same or substantially the same form for a period of one year next succeeding the Council's final action on the original petition. A member voting with the majority on the original petition, shall be privileged to reintroduce such a petition.

A liquor license or special entertainment permit, or an amendment proposed by the licensee to an existing license or permit that has been denied ~~once presented to and finally acted upon~~ by the Council shall not be received by the Council in the same or substantially the same form ~~nor shall any proposed amendments by an applicant to either a license or a permit be taken up and acted upon by the Council~~ for one year from the date of such action unless a shorter period is required by state law.
