AMENDMENT TO PORTLAND CITY CODE
CHAPTER 14 LAND USE
SECTION 14-217.5 OLD PORT OVERLAY ZONE

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND,
MAINE IN CITY COUNCIL ASSEMBLED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. *That Section 14-217.5 of the Portland City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:*

Sec. 14.217.5. Old Port Overlay zone.

...

- (c) *Limitation on number of licenses:* The total number of entertainment licenses available in the Old Port overlay zone shall be forty (40). Twenty-seven (27) of the licenses shall be initially available for bars, and the remaining thirteen (13) shall be initially for all other entertainment uses. Nonbar licenses may exceed thirteen (13) in number at any given time provided that the total number of entertainment licenses shall not exceed forty (40). Effective October 17, 2005 the total number of entertainment licenses available to bars shall not exceed twenty-two (24). A new entertainment use cannot locate in the Old Port overlay zone unless an entertainment license is available for that type of use. Applications for entertainment licenses in use categories where a license is not available at the time of submission of the application shall be held for one (1) year from the date of the submission. In the event that an entertainment license becomes available for an

entertainment use type, a lottery will be held among
the applications then on file.
