**RESOLUTION ON THE SECESSION OF PEAKS ISLAND FROM
THE CITY OF PORTLAND**

WHEREAS, State law establishes a procedure pursuant to which one part of a community may secede from another and whereas that process calls for an advisory referendum in the secession territory; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to that state law the registered voters on Peaks Island voted in an advisory referendum on June 13, 2006; and

WHEREAS, In that advisory referendum more than 50% of the registered voters on Peaks Island voted in favor of secession; and

WHEREAS, the state law now requires the council to take a recorded vote on whether to support and approve the request for secession.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Portland City Council supports and approves (or) does not support and approve this secession request.
