AMENDMENT TO PORTLAND CITY CODE
Chapter 14 (LAND USE), Article VI (BOARD OF APPEALS),
Section 14-548 (QUORUM AND NECESSARY VOTE)
RE: NECESSARY NUMBER OF VOTES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND,
MAINE IN CITY COUNCIL ASSEMBLED AS FOLLOWS:

1. *That Section Sec. 14-548 of the Portland City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:*

Sec. 14-548. Quorum and necessary vote.

No business shall be transacted by the board of appeals without a quorum, consisting of four (4) members, being present. ~~Except as expressly provided herein, the~~ The concurring vote of at least four (4) members of the board shall be necessary to ~~authorize any action, to~~ grant any request or application or to sustain any appeal. Any matter that receives fewer than four (4) votes shall be deemed to have been denied.
