ORDER AMENDING RIVERSIDE RECYCLING PUNCH PASS PROGRAM RE: ADMINISTRATIVE CHANGES

ORDERED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to adopt rules to amend the residential punch pass program at the Riverside Recycling Center, established by Council Order 234 and passed on May 19, 2003, for the purpose of maintaining the financial viability of the program. Such rules adopted by the City Manager may include the maximum number of punches allowed per pass, the types of items to be disposed of through the punch pass system, and the limits on items to be accepted by the Riverside Recycling Center for each punch;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager shall provide the City Council with notice of any fee changes prior to implementation;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Department of Public Works will provide an annual report to the Council on the residential punch-pass program as part of the budget process; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that this Order shall automatically terminate as of June 30, 2009.
