**ORDER APPROVING STATE/LOCAL EPS FUNDING ALLOCATION  
FOR PORTLAND SCHOOLS FOR FY'2009**

**ORDERED**, that under and pursuant to the City's Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Appropriation Resolve [Order No. 248] and applicable state law the City hereby approves the following school budget article for fiscal year 2008-2009.

Appropriation for State/Local EPS Funding Allocation (20-A M.R.S.A. §15690(1A-B)).

That the City appropriate \$\$65,056,017 for the total cost of funding public education from kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act and that the City raise \$50,129,770 as the City's contribution to the total cost of funding public education from kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15688.

***Explanation:** The City's contribution to the total cost of funding public education from kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act is the amount of money determined by state law to be the minimum amount that the City must raise in order to receive the full amount of state dollars.*
