FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009 APPROPRIATION RESOLVE

RESOLVED, that the sum of \$185,045,318 is hereby appropriated for Fiscal Year 2009 for General Municipal purposes as shown in the Finance Committee's recommended budget dated May 5, 2008; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Assessor of Taxes of the City of Portland be and hereby is directed to assess a tax upon all real estate liable to be taxed therein and to assess the owner of, or such other persons as may be liable by law for, personal property liable to be taxed therein on the first day of April, 2008 and not exempt from taxation, to the aggregate amount of \$131,635,262.00, said amount being the combined tax levy necessary to support the fiscal year 2009 appropriation for general municipal purposes shown above and the fiscal year 2009 appropriation for the total school budget of \$89,513,123.00 approved by the voters on May 13, 2008, and in accordance with the provisions of the Statutes of Maine; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, all taxes assessed as above and committed to the Director of Finance shall be due on September 12, 2008, and payable in two equal installments, the first due on the 12th day of September, 2008, and the second installment due on the 13th day of March, 2009. The delinquency rate of interest shall be eleven per cent (11%) per annum on all payments received after the respective due dates and the abatement rate of interest shall be seven percent (7%) per annum.
