ORDER DECLARING 42nd ANNUAL (2007) WCSH-TV SIDEWALK ART FESTIVAL

ORDERED, that the 42nd Annual WCSH-TV Sidewalk Art Festival be and hereby is declared on Saturday, August 25, 2007 or, in the event of rain, on Sunday, August 26, 2007;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Festival area shall be Congress Street (the street itself), sidewalks and squares, from Park Street to Elm Street (Monument Square/One City Center) and Casco, Brown, Center and Preble Streets that connect with Congress Street;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Festival area shall be closed to traffic from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 25, or the rain date, except High Street shall remain open;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that a parking ban is hereby authorized beginning Friday, August 24, 2007 at 6:00 p.m. through 6:00 p.m. Saturday, August 25, 2007. In the event the Festival is postponed from August 25 to August 26, the parking ban shall occur twenty-four (24) hours later than stated above;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that said parking ban shall be on both sides of Congress Street from Park Street to Elm Street, including side streets (Casco, Brown, Preble and Center for one block) and on both sides of the public way running from Congress Street to the parking garage at Monument Square (Federal Street Extension);

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is authorized to issue a revocable permit under Sec. 25-27 of the City Code to WCSH-TV for use of the above described area for the Festival, subject to the following conditions:

*No sale of alcoholic beverages on the streets or public property during the Festival;

*WCSH-TV shall defend, indemnify and hold the City harmless from and against all claims arising out of activities during said Festival and shall provide and maintain public liability insurance coverage in the amount of

at least \$400,000, combined single limit for personal or bodily injury, death, or property damage, with the City of Portland named as an additional insured thereon;

*WCSH-TV shall reimburse any costs incurred by city departments in providing services for the Festival, including but not limited to, police department charges, public works fees, parking control fees, inspection services fees, city clerk's license fees and parks and recreation fees;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is authorized to issue such other temporary licenses, including licenses for food service establishments, as may be required by the City Code, provided all other applicable requirements of said Code have been met regarding the operation of the Festival.
