**RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2009-2010 CONSOLIDATED HOUSING AND
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ANNUAL ACTION PLAN INCLUDING
APPROPRIATIONS FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
PROGRAM, HOME PROGRAM, AND EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT
PROGRAM
AND CERTIFICATIONS PERTAINING THERETO TO ACCEPT AND
ALLOCATE FEDERAL FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the City of Portland, Maine has determined that there are pressing community and neighborhood needs for further federal assistance for housing and community development activities; and

WHEREAS, annual activities for the Consolidated Housing and Community Development Annual Action Plan were recommended and approved in Resolution 12-08/09 on March 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has allocated the City of Portland additional Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Funds in the amount of \$29,296 for the program year 2009-2010 under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-383) as amended from time to time; an additional HOME Program Grant allocation of \$732,367; and an additional \$105 of Emergency Shelter Grant Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Portland, Maine, desires to utilize the original grants and these additional funds to support housing and community development activities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council of the City of Portland, Maine, hereby adopts the amended 2009-2010 Consolidated Housing and Community Development Plans; and appropriates the sums of \$2,328,388 for the Community Development Block Grant Program, \$1,492,142 for the HOME Program and \$93,923 for the Emergency Shelter Grant Program for the purposes approved in the attached Plan and budgets as recommended by the City Manager; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City of Portland, Maine, possesses legal authority to apply for the above referenced Community Development Block Grant Program Funds, HOME Program funds and Emergency Shelter Grant Program funds for the Program Year 2009-2010; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City Manager is authorized to:

- 1) Apply for, accept and expend the Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Funds of \$2,138,825 and to expend program income and reprogrammed funds up to a total of \$189,563; \$1,387,142 of HOME Program funds; and to expend HOME program income up to a total of \$105,000 and \$93,323 of Emergency Shelter Grant funds; and
- 2) Officially represent the City of Portland, Maine, in connection with the application, including the execution of contracts on behalf of the City; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

- 1) The additional \$29,296 of CDBG funds is appropriated as follows: \$19,671 to the Residential Rehab Program, \$4,812.50 to Spiral Arts, Inc. for the artful aging program, and \$4,812.50 the Munjoy Hill Neighborhood Association for the neighborhood service corp program; and
- 2) The additional \$105 of Emergency Shelter Grant funds is appropriated to the Indigent Care Program; and
- 3) The additional \$199,114 of HOME funds is appropriated as follows: \$73,234 to fund administration and \$125,880 to fund new residential construction; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City of Portland, Maine certifies that it will comply with all of the attached assurances; and provide such additional information as may be required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the foregoing 2009-2010 HCD funds are hereby appropriated pursuant to the budget attached hereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, this Resolution is enacted as an Emergency to take effect immediately, pursuant to Article II, Section 8 of the Portland City Charter.
