**ORDER DECLARING  
SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 13, 2010  
“PORTLAND WINTERUSH 2010 FESTIVAL”**

**ORDERED**, that the City hereby declares that Saturday, February 13, 2010 as "Portland WinteRush" Festival” to include snow and ice carving contest, Neighborhood Association snowman contest, snow painting, snowshoeing and cross country skiing, snowboarding, sliding down “Hannaford Hill” (a Public Services made mountain of snow on State Street Ext.), Nordic Sprint races, skating, outdoor games, and storytelling and informational talks on Winter habitat. The Portland School PTO’s will be selling refreshments and winter clothing at the festival.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that in order for the festival to be held, State Street Extension needs to be closed to vehicular traffic Saturday, February 13 from 12:01 a.m. to 8 p.m.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that some park roadways will be closed to vehicular traffic.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the festival area: Deering Oaks Park, including all sidewalks around the park, State Street Extension, as well as the Rose Garden side of Deering Oaks will be closed to street vendors pursuant to Section 19-17 of the Portland City Code and is reserved for the use of the City of Portland for the purpose of administering the Festival.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the City Manager is also authorized to issue such other temporary licenses and temporary permits, including licenses for food service establishments, and permits for sales of non-food related items, as may be required by the Portland City Code, provided that all applicable requirements of said code have been met regarding the operation of said event.
