**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PORTLAND JETPORT REVENUE BONDS**

The Portland City Council will hold a public hearing on February 1, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at Portland City Hall, 389 Congress Street, to consider orders authorizing:

(1) Up to \$72,605,000 of Portland Jetport Revenue Bonds to finance a portion of the costs to design, construct and equip an expansion and renovation to the Portland International Jetport Terminal, which expansion and renovation includes but is not limited to construction of a 137,000 square foot expansion to and a 10,000 square foot renovation of the existing terminal building, a new ticketing concourse, a new security screening checkpoint, a new baggage handling system with an inline explosion detection system, an over-roadway connection to the parking facilities, additional aircraft gates with passenger boarding bridges, enlarged concessions space, a new multilane terminal roadway, and additional surface parking totaling approximately 497 spaces, and to fund a debt service reserve fund and other expenses incidental and related thereto including costs of issuance. Such Jetport Revenue Bonds shall be payable solely from revenues derived from the operation of the Portland International Jetport.

and

(2) Up to \$12,000,000 of Portland Jetport Revenue Bonds to finance a portion of the costs of the following improvements at the Jetport, together with certain costs of issuance and all other costs related and ancillary thereto:

- Design, construction, installation and equipping of a concrete aircraft deicing fluid capture apron and associated fluid recovery building for the capture and recovery of spent aircraft deicing fluid.
- Design, construction, installation and equipping of a concrete terminal aircraft apron to accommodate the planned expansion of and renovation to the Jetport terminal building.

The foregoing list is a non-exhaustive list of projects that will be considered by the City Council at said public hearing or prior to final City Council action and may be expanded, reduced or revised by the City Council at said public hearing or prior to final City Council action.
