**ORDER APPROVING CONTRIBUTION TO TOTAL COST  
OF FUNDING PUBLIC EDUCATION FROM KINDERGARTEN TO GRADE 12  
FOR PORTLAND SCHOOLS FOR FY2011**

**ORDERED**, that under and pursuant to the City's Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Appropriation Resolve [Order No. 227-09/10] and applicable state law the City hereby approves the following school budget article for fiscal year 2010-2011:

School Administrative Unit Contribution to Total Cost of Funding Public Education from Kindergarten to Grade 12 (20-A M.R.S.A. §15690(1A-B)): That the City appropriates for the total cost of public education from kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act, the amount of \$73,214,577 and further appropriates as the City's contribution to the total cost of funding education from kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act, in accordance with Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15688, the sum of \$57,155,805.

***Explanation:*** *The City's contribution to the total cost of funding education from kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act is the amount of money determined by state law to be the minimum amount that a municipality must raise in order to receive the full amount of state dollars.*
