**ORDER DECLARING "MUNJFEST 2009"
A MUNJOY HILL STREET FESTIVAL
SEPTEMBER 19, 2009**

ORDERED, that Saturday, September 19, 2009 from 11:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., is hereby declared "MunjFest 2009" and the City Manager is hereby authorized pursuant to §25-27 of the Portland City Code to grant permits to the Munjoy Hill Neighborhood Organization for said Festival, including but not limited to, the following activity:

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that any insurance requirements for the street festival are waived;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the following streets will be closed from 10 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 19, 2009:

- Congress Street (from North Street to Munjoy Street)
- One block of St. Lawrence, Atlantic and Lafayette Streets (leading up to Congress Street)

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, alcoholic beverages shall not be sold on the streets or public property of said area during said Festival;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that Festival areas will be closed to street vendors pursuant to §19-17 of the Portland City Code and the City Manager is authorized to issue such other temporary licenses for the Festival, including temporary food service licenses, as may be required by the Portland City Code, provided that all applicable requirements of the Code have been met.
