ORDER DECLARING 45th ANNUAL (2010) WCSH-TV SIDEWALK ART FESTIVAL

ORDERED, that the 45th Annual WCSH-TV Sidewalk Art Festival be and hereby is declared on Saturday, August 28, 2010 or, in the event of rain, on Sunday, August 29, 2010;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Festival area shall be Congress Street (the street itself), sidewalks and squares, from Park Street to Elm Street (Monument Square/One City Center) and Casco, Brown, Center and Preble Streets that connect with Congress Street;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Festival area shall be closed to traffic from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 28, or the rain date, except High Street shall remain open;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that a parking ban is hereby authorized beginning Friday, August 27, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. through 6:00 p.m. Saturday, August 28, 2010. In the event the Festival is postponed from August 28 to August 29, the parking ban shall occur twenty-four (24) hours later than stated above;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that said parking ban shall be on both sides of Congress Street from Park Street to Elm Street, including side streets (Casco, Brown, Preble and Center for one block) and on both sides of the public way running from Congress Street to the parking garage at Monument Square (Federal Street Extension);

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is authorized to issue a revocable permit under Sec. 25-27 of the City Code to WCSH-TV for use of the above described area for the Festival, subject to the following conditions:

*No sale of alcoholic beverages on the streets or public property during the Festival;

*WCSH-TV shall defend, indemnify and hold the City harmless from and against all claims arising out of activities during said Festival and shall provide and maintain public liability insurance coverage in the amount of

at least \$400,000, combined single limit for personal or bodily injury, death, or property damage, with the City of Portland named as an additional insured thereon;

*WCSH-TV shall reimburse city departments for services, licenses, and materials.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is authorized to issue such other temporary licenses, including licenses for food service establishments, as may be required by the City Code, provided all other applicable requirements of said Code have been met regarding the operation of the Festival.
