**ORDER APPROVING STATE/LOCAL EPS FUNDING ALLOCATION
FOR PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOR FY 2012**

ORDERED, that under and pursuant to the City's Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Appropriation Resolve [Order No. 229] and applicable state law the City hereby approves the following school budget article for Fiscal Year 2011-2012:

Appropriation for State/Local EPS funding Allocation (20-A M.R.S.A. §15690(1A-B)): That the City appropriates the amount of \$74,452,585 for the total cost of public education from kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act, and raises the amount of \$61,230,843 as the City's contribution to the total cost of funding education from kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act, in accordance with Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15688.

State Mandated Explanation: The City's contribution to the total cost of funding education from kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act is the amount of money determined by state law to be the minimum amount that the City must raise in order to receive the full amount of state dollars.
