**ORDER DECLARING
COMPASS PROJECT'S
8th ANNUAL
"FAMILY BOAT BUILDING EVENT"
FESTIVAL
JULY 8, 2011 – JULY 10, 2011**

ORDERED, that Friday, July 8, 2011 through Sunday, July 10, 2011, is hereby declared "Family Boat Building Event" Festival and the City Manager is hereby authorized pursuant to §25-27 of the Portland City Code to grant permits to the Compass Project for said Festival, including but not limited to, the following activity:

Compass Project is authorized to erect two large tents on Preble Street grass area where over the course of three days 20 families will each make an 11-foot wooden boat, which is then launched at East End Beach. The tents will go up on Thursday, July 7, 2011 and will be removed on Monday night (July 11, 2011). In conjunction with the boat building, there is music and entertainment planned, food vendors on site and knot tying exhibitions and nautical activities for children and adults;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that in order to facilitate the event, the organizer has requested that the south side of the parking lot be set aside for their use, and the small grass area beside the parking lot also be available; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that some additional parking spaces (25-50) may also be needed at the parking lot; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the festival zone for the event is the right side of the Preble Street parking lot and the grass area beside it, and all abutting sidewalks; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Compass Project shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City of Portland, its officers and employees, from and against all claims arising out of or resulting from the parade and festival activities and/or use of City streets and property for said parade and festival activities, and shall

procure and maintain public liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$400,000 combined single limit for personal or bodily injury, death or property damage and covering the obligation of indemnification hereunder. The Compass Project shall provide the City with a certificate showing evidence of such insurance and showing the City as an additional insured on said insurance;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, alcoholic beverages shall not be sold on the streets or public property of said area during said Festival;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that Parks and Recreation permit fees for use of the square will be \$40 per day;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that Compass Project shall have sole authority over participating vendors at the event and may charge a fee to vendors for the opportunity to vend at the Boat Building Festival; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that conditions of grounds, specified in a permit issued Recreation, shall be adhered to; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that Festival areas will be closed to street vendors pursuant to §19-17 of the Portland City Code and the City Manager is authorized to issue such other temporary licenses for the Festival, including temporary food service licenses, as may be required by the Portland City Code, provided that all applicable requirements of the Code have been met.
