**ORDER DECLARING
FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 3, 2012
“DOWNTOWN SHOWDOWN 2012 FESTIVAL”**

ORDERED, that the Downtown Showdown will kick off the 4th annual Downtown Showdown Festival: Maine’s Coolest Outdoor Festival, which is scheduled for February 3rd at Monument Square.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that events at Downtown Showdown include: Snowboard & Ski Rail Championship.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that Downtown Showdown is sponsored by Sunday River/Sugarloaf. Sunday River employees will construct a competition ramp on Monument Square (similar to last Year’s ramp). The building of the ramp will take place Thursday and Friday, February 2 & 3. Removal will take place on Saturday - Monday, February 4 - 6th.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that in order for the festival to be held, the following city streets will need to be closed to traffic:

Federal Street Extension: 8:00 a.m. – Midnight, Friday February 3, 2012

Federal Street Extension: will need to be posted “No Parking” 8:00 a.m. – Midnight, Friday February 3, 2012.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the festival area: Monument Square and Federal Street Ext., and all adjoining sidewalks will be closed to street vendors pursuant to Section 19-17 of the Portland City Code and is reserved for the use of the organizers for the purpose of administering the Festival.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is also authorized to issue such other temporary licenses and temporary permits, including licenses for food service establishments, and permits for sales of non-food related items, as may be required by the Portland City Code, provided that all applicable requirements of said code have been met regarding the operation of said event.
