**ORDER DECLARING
SATURDAY, MAY 19, 2012
FROM 10:00 A.M. – 4:00 P.M.
“WEST FEST 2012”**

ORDERED, that the City hereby declares that Saturday, May 19, 2012 as "West Fest 2012" as a West End Neighborhood Festival to be held at the Reiche School/Community Center and be used as a fundraiser for the West End Neighborhood Association. The festival will feature musicians, a yard sale, artists and crafters, kid activities and a bake sale; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, lunch will be offered by West End businesses; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that a horse drawn wagon will give tours of the West End; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to issue a revocable permit under §§25-26 -- 25-30 of the Portland City Code to the West End Neighborhood Association, Parkside Neighborhood Association and the St. John/Valley Neighborhood Association subject to the following conditions:

- * Under no circumstances may alcoholic beverages be sold on City of Portland rights-of-way in the festival area during said event;
- * City permit and license fees for the event shall be waived;
- * The City will not require a certificate of insurance in order for the event to be held on city property;
- * Conditions for use of grounds, specified in a permit issued from Recreation, shall be adhered to; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is also authorized to issue such other temporary licenses, including licenses for food service establishments, as may be required by the Portland City Code, provided that all other applicable requirements of said Code have been met regarding the operation of said festival/event.
