ORDER AMENDING
COUNCIL RULE 33 – COUNCIL COMMITTEES~~S~~
AND
COUNCIL RULE 35 – COUNCIL COMMITTEES; PUBLIC COMMENT

ORDERED, that Council Rule 33 (Council Committee) and Council Rule 35 (Council Committees; Public Comment) are hereby amended as follows:

Rule 33. Council Committees

At the commencement of the municipal year, or as soon thereafter as possible, ~~there shall be chosen~~ members shall be appointed to the following standing committees, each committee to consist of ~~such four~~ members of the Council ~~as the Council may designate~~ except for the Legislative Committee which shall have five (5) members.

1. Finance Committee
2. Public Safety, Health and Human Services Committee
3. Nomination Committee ~~Appointments and Non-Union Personnel Committee~~
4. Housing and Community Development Committee

- ~~5~~6. Legislative Committee

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Rule 35. Council Committees; Public Comment

The public will be given an opportunity to comment on any item under consideration by the below-named standing committees prior to a final committee action on that item. Rules governing the procedure for such public comment shall be determined by each committee. This requirement for public comment shall apply to the following:

1. Finance Committee;
2. Public Safety, Health and Human Services Committee;
3. Nomination Committee;
34. Housing and Community Development Committee;
- ~~4. Housing Committee;~~
5. Legislative Committee;
- ~~6. Health and Recreation;~~
76. Transportation, Sustainability and Energy Committee; and
- ~~8. Energy and Environmental Sustainability~~

Nothing herein shall prevent or prohibit any other committee from accepting public comment if said committee determines that it wishes to do so.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, no public comment shall be required on the following items: informational reports or communications from boards and commissions, staff or other organizations or entities; and administrative action implementing prior committee action where that prior action had permitted public comment.
