**ORDER DECLARING 48th ANNUAL (2013)
WCSH-TV SIDEWALK ART FESTIVAL**

ORDERED, that the 48th Annual WCSH-TV Sidewalk Art Festival be and hereby is declared on Saturday, August 24, 2013 or, in the event of rain, on Sunday, August 25, 2013;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Festival area shall be Congress Street (the street itself), sidewalks and squares, from Park Street to Elm Street (Monument Square/One City Center) and Casco, Brown, Center and Preble Streets that connect with Congress Street;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Festival area shall be closed to traffic from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 24, or the rain date, except High Street shall remain open;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that a parking ban is hereby authorized beginning Friday, August 23, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. through 6:00 p.m. Saturday, August 24, 2013. In the event the Festival is postponed from August 24 to August 25, the parking ban shall occur twenty-four (24) hours later than stated above;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that said parking ban shall be on both sides of Congress Street from Park Street to Elm Street, including side streets (Casco, Brown, Preble and Center for one block) and on both sides of the public way running from Congress Street to the parking garage at Monument Square (Federal Street Extension);

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is authorized to issue a revocable permit under Sec. 25-27 of the City Code to WCSH-TV for use of the above described area for the Festival, subject to the following conditions:

*No sale of alcoholic beverages on the streets or public property during the Festival;

*WCSH-TV shall defend, indemnify and hold the City harmless from and against all claims arising out of activities during said Festival and shall provide and maintain public liability insurance coverage in the amount of at least \$400,000, combined single limit for personal or bodily injury,

death, or property damage, with the City of Portland named as an additional insured thereon;

*WCSH-TV shall reimburse the Police Department for services, and the City Clerk's office for licenses.

*Guidelines for use, issued in a permit for use by the Public Services Event Office shall be adhered to.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is authorized to issue such other temporary licenses, including licenses for food service establishments, as may be required by the City Code, provided all other applicable requirements of said Code have been met regarding the operation of the Festival.
