**ORDER DECLARING
“SUNDAYS ON THE BOULEVARD”
AS ANNUALLY RECURRING FESTIVAL DAYS**

ORDERED, that Baxter Boulevard between Vannah Avenue and the entrance to Payson Park be closed to traffic every Sunday, beginning each year, starting in 2014, on the Sunday closest to Earth Day and ending on the Sunday closest to Veterans Day, in order to allow the public to use that portion of the street as a recreational space, which days are hereby declared to be “Sundays on the Boulevard” Festival Days; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that, in 2014, every Sunday from April 20, 2014 to November 9, 2014 are hereby declared to be “Sundays on the Boulevard” Festival Days; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that, as stated above, the following street shall be closed to traffic on each “Sundays on the Boulevard” Festival Day:

9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Baxter Boulevard from Vannah Avenue to the entrance to Payson Park;

Signage and barricades will be used to ensure pedestrian safety; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that in addition to city staff, volunteers from advocate groups have expressed a willingness to help with traffic control alerts, clean up and litter control, as well as to publicize the event throughout the community; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Festival shall be closed to licensed street vendors as provided in §19-17 of the City Code; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Manager is authorized to issue such other temporary licenses, including licenses for food service establishments or food trucks, as may be required and allowed by the City Code, provided that all other applicable Code requirements for the operation of the Festival has been met.
