**ORDER DECLARING “INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL FAMILY FUN DAY”  
ON BAXTER BOULEVARD**

**ORDERED**, that the Wings of Hope Alliance for Cambodia Incorporation has requested that Saturday, August 8, 2009 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. be declared as "International Festival Family Fun Day," to be held on Baxter Boulevard (from Vannah Ave to the 2<sup>nd</sup> entrance to Payson Park). The Committee is a culturally diverse group of volunteers committed to raising funds to benefit the orphan children and impoverished citizens in Cambodia; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that cars traveling west from Tukey’s Bridge, would need to take a right turn into the 1<sup>st</sup> entrance of the park (just after Seaside Nursing Home) and continue up to Ocean Ave for a detour. Traffic coming east on Baxter Boulevard would be diverted up Vannah Ave (away from the festival zone) for a detour; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the use of Payson Park (just the park roadway – from the tip of the grass triangle, down to Baxter Blvd) from 6:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. for volunteer and organizer parking; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the main festival area is centered around the Baxter Blvd area closest to the Portland Water District Pump Station. A stage for musical entertainment and announcements would be set up on the roadway near the pump station; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the Boulevard itself would be where food vendors and craft vendors would set up their booths and 10x10 canopies extending down the Boulevard beside the Cheverus High School field area; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that Baxter Boulevard both lanes (from Vannah Ave to the 2<sup>nd</sup> entrance to Payson Park) will be closed down to vehicular traffic on Saturday, August 8, 2009 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (Back Cove pathway will still be open and available for recreational use); and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that organizers are working on securing parking at Cheverus High School, Dyer’s Flat (at Payson Park), St. Pius Church, parking lots off Marginal

Way, and surrounding streets. Limited “vendor parking” would be allowed on the Boulevard (close to the Vannah Ave intersection).

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the festival area will be closed to street vendors pursuant to Section 19-17 of the Portland City Code and is reserved for the use of the Wings of Hope Alliance for Cambodia Incorporation for the purpose of conducting the International Festival Family Fun Day Events, subject to the direction and control of the City Manager; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the City Manager is authorized to issue a revocable permit under Section 25-27 of the Municipal Code to the Wing of Hope Alliance for Cambodia Incorporation for the use of the above-described area for said Festival, subject to the following conditions:

- The Wings of Hope Alliance for Cambodia Incorporation Committee, Chairs, Chanbopha Himm and Channary Prak, shall reimburse the City for all expenses incurred by City Departments for said Festival;
- The Wings of Hope Alliance for Cambodia Incorporation shall hire at least two police officers to staff the closed intersections at Baxter Blvd, and may be required to hire parking control officers to enforce parking regulations for the festival;
- The Wings of Hope Alliance for Cambodia Incorporation shall be solely responsible for trash cleanup at the festival and shall be required to leave a security deposit (amount determined by the Dir. Of Parks and Rec) on file at the Parks & Recreation Office;
- Under no circumstances may alcoholic beverages be sold on the streets or public property of said area during said festival;
- The Wings of Hope Alliance for Cambodia Incorporation shall have sole authority over participating vendors at the event and may charge a fee to vendors for the opportunity to vend at the Festival;
- Conditions for use of grounds and requirements for food service, vending sales, tent and stage installations, and other items specified in a permit issued from Parks & Recreation shall be adhered to; and
- The Wings of Hope Alliance for Cambodia Incorporation shall defend and indemnify the City and hold it harmless from and against all claims arising out of activities during said Festival, and shall take out and maintain public liability insurance coverage in the amount of at least \$400,000 combined single limit for personal or bodily injury, death or property damage for said purpose. This insurance certificate

will also list the City of Portland as an additional insured in regards to the “International Festival Family Fun Day” activities.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED,** that the City Manager is authorized to issue such other temporary licenses and temporary permits, including licenses for food service establishments and permits for sales of non-food related items, as may be required by the Portland City Code, provided that all applicable requirements of said code have been met regarding the operation of said event.
